Below is a full list of daily sessions available over the summer in our Holiday Activity Fun Programme. Once you have picked your days click on the QR code to get them booked in.

Paint, Draw, and Imagine Mon 7 July	On Paint, Draw, and Imagine Day, children will explore colour, movement, and storytelling through playful mark-making and big shared creations. Inspired by Cornwall's wild landscapes and creative spirit, they'll work together on giant imaginative scenes using brushes and sponges.
Collage and creation Tues 8 July	On Collage & Creation Station day, children will dive into playful textures, colours, and shapes using everything from feathers and fabric to cardboard and leaves. With big shared canvases and hands-on stations, the focus is on imagination, sensory fun, and creative freedom.
